Thesis: Christians should Change the way they think by mediating on the Word.

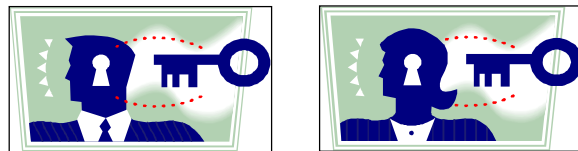
I. Praise to God v.4-5 ⁴Rejoice in the Lord

II. Prayer to God v.6-7 ⁶Do not be anxious

and petition, with thanksgiving, present your
requests to God. ⁷And the peace of God,
which transcends all understanding, will
guard your hearts and your minds in Christ
Jesus.

III. Pondering to God v.8 ⁸Finally,
brothers, whatever is true, whatever is
noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure,

whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

IV. Peace of God v. 9 ⁹Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.
